## Helping Youth Build Resilience

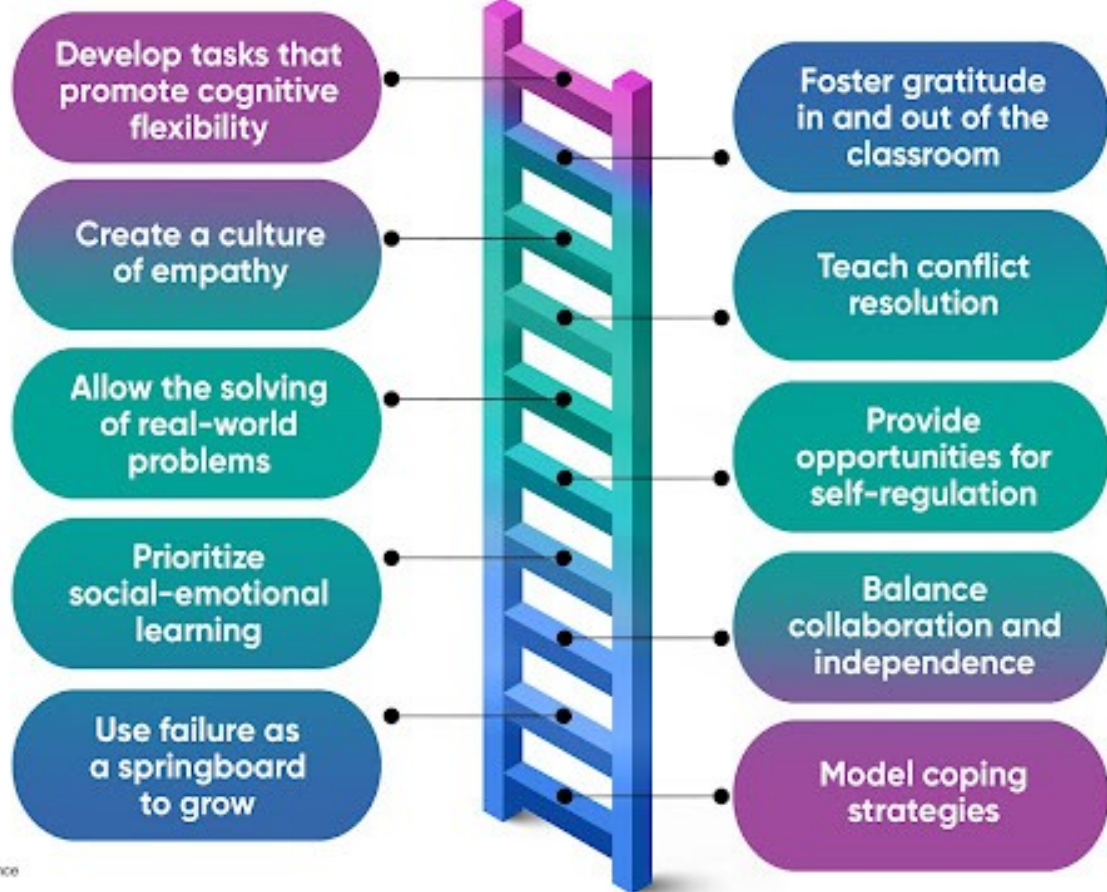

### Requirements

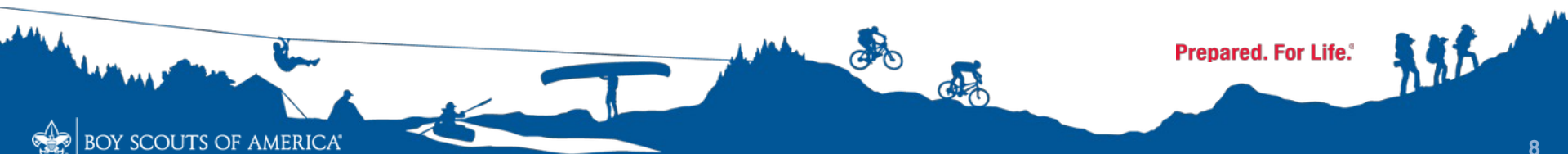

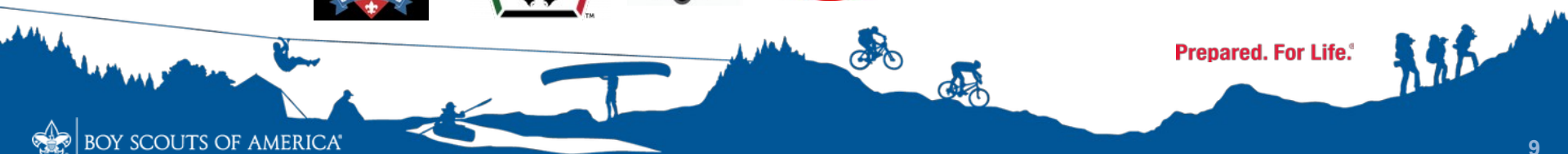
